Trinity Lutheran Church Proposed Constitutional Amendments

The following are two proposed changes to the Trinity Lutheran Church Constitution recommended by the Trinity Lutheran Church Council. These amendments are to be voted on by the congregation at the Annual Meeting on January 26, 2025.

Original wording:

C13.02. A *Nominating Committee* of six voting members of this congregation, two of whom, if possible, shall be outgoing members of the Congregation Council, shall be elected at the annual meeting for a term of one year. Members of the Nominating Committee are not eligible for consecutive re-election.

Proposed change:

C13.02. A *Nominating Committee* of six voting members of this congregation, two of whom, if possible, shall be outgoing members of the Congregation Council, shall be elected at the annual meeting for a term of one year. A maximum of two members of the Nominating Committee are eligible for re-election to serve no more than two consecutive terms.

Original wording:

C12.05. The Congregation Council shall be responsible for the financial and property matters of this congregation.

c. The Congregation Council may enter into contracts of up to \$2,000 for items not included in the budget.

Proposed change:

C12.05. The Congregation Council shall be responsible for the financial and property matters of this congregation.

c. The Congregation Council may enter into contracts of up to \$10,000 for items not included in the budget.
